## Democrats Unleash Their Gun Control Rhetoric — Again

Hayley Geftman-Gold, the network's now-former vice president and senior counsel, took to Facebook after a gunman opened fire at the Route 91 Harvest Music Festival in Las Vegas, killing at least 58 people and sending more than 500 others to hospitals.

"If they wouldn't do anything when children were murdered I have no hope that Repugs [sic] will ever do the right thing," Geftman-Gold wrote in a now-deleted message that was first reported and captured by <u>The Daily Caller</u>.[1]

You must really question the character of a person that has no feelings for innocent people that are murdered in cold blood for no other reason than they were in the wrong place at the wrong time. "In fact, Chuck, every one of the mass shootings except two in America since 1950 have been" in "gun-free zones," his implication being that wrongdoers don't open fire in places where permitted citizens may have loaded handguns.[3]

We will see them put forth a bevy of purposed laws making it harder and harder for citizens to be able to protect themselves and nothing to keep guns out of the hands of those who wish to do others harm. They actually teach a hatred of America: A professor from Ithaca College in New York argues that the song "God Bless America" should not be played at sporting events because it is a "warmongering song."

Professor Stephen Mosher, who teaches in the Department of Communications Studies, wrote an op-ed for The Ithacan titled "Sporting events don't need national anthem," in which he complains that after the events of September 11, 2001, "expressions of hyper-patriotism took hold," including the "warmongering song 'God Bless America'" becoming our second, unofficial anthem.[4]
