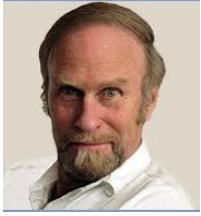


Has America Become TOO Big to Solve Its Problems?

But it wasn't until I reached China that my entire world view changed. Back in 1984, that country housed 1.2 billion. Today, 1.4 billion, and growing 8 million, net gain annually. Then, India at 1.1 billion. Today, 1.42 billion people, and growing by 16 million annually, net gain. India outranks China in

numbers in 2023. They are both on a collision course with horrific pollution, lack of resources, massive poverty, diseases, horrible subsistence living conditions, and non-existent quality of life.

I floated the Yangtze River in China. Polluted beyond comprehension! Chemicals, human waste, animal waste, sewage of every kind floated out into the ocean to create a 20,000 square mile dead zone. They are SO BIG; they cannot solve their problems. They are SO overpopulated; they can't feed their own people. They have created a living nightmare for all their citizens.
