I would rather you made your appraisal after seeing what the enemy does, since it is certain that, angered and outraged, he will soon launch a determined counterattack'."

In short, what Adam Schiff has done is anger and outrage 63 million or more people who voted or who wish they had voted for Donald Trump in 2016. You will just have to wait until next November to see the result of our counterattack.

Your silence and lack of support for President Trump is a direct insult to all of us who want him as our President.
