State Rep. Gene Wu, the ringleader of this circus, spouted nonsense about fighting a “racist gerrymander.” Racist? This map is pure politics, drawn to reflect Texas’s red reality after Trump’s triumphant push. Paxton nailed it: these maps are defensible, politically based, and unbreakable in court. Democrats know they’re losing ground, so they resort to flight. But flight is treason to duty. Abbott warned them: return or forfeit your seats. Paxton filed suits to oust them, targeting 13 loudmouths who bragged about their defiance. And yet, they waltzed back on August 18,

expecting a pat on the back?

No. House Speaker Dustin Burrows didn't mince words. He assigned law enforcement escorts – plainclothes DPS troopers – to shadow these fugitives until Wednesday's session.
