

Thomas Friedman and Charlie Rose versus the American people

New York Times journalist Thomas Friedman writes pithy commentaries and best selling books that exemplify his Pulitzer Prize winning legacy. His latest: Thank You for Being Late.

Charlie Rose continues as the forever host on CBS Early Morning, and his own PBS program where he interviews people attempting to make a difference in the world.

Friedman's last book, Hot, Flat and Crowded, addressed our overpopulated world. But in the end, he hoped for a new non-polluting energy source to save the human race in its fecundity juggernaut now destroying much of the natural world. If humans gain an endless energy source, they (we) would accelerate our numbers with more food created by that energy.

While Friedman's book spoke of our consequences, he jumped the tracks to encourage further growth.

They arrived here out of the bush having never used a toilet or taken a shower. Today, they subsist on our taxpayer dollars via welfare for everything. The EBT card gives them life! Somali youth push old people off their bicycles for laughs and show it on social media. Educating them: hopeless.

Yet, Friedman, who will never live in a 'diversity or multicultural' housing area, writes about how wonderful it is for all those in Minneapolis. Balderdash! Ask the same question to any homegrown Americans who fled Detroit, Michigan now known as "Dearbornistan."
