## Trump: Let's call this man president of the United States

"The fundamental problem with the immigration status quo is that it serves the needs of wealthy donors, political activists and powerful politicians," said Donald Trump. "The current system does not serve you, the American people."

An average of 350,000 illegal, pregnant women travel to the USA annually to birth their "anchor babies" that immediately collect enormous welfare benefits from the American taxpayer. An astounding 41 percent of illegal aliens overstay their visas to blend into enclaves already established. Legal and illegal immigrants send \$80 billion in cash transfers back to their home countries annually—thus financially bleeding America to death.
