Bryan Eastman was elected on his first try (2022) to Gainesville City Commission and served as mayor pro-tem in that city for a period of time. Eastman managed Obama's campaigns. Then, Ashley Gantt, FLHD 109 won, and is currently the sponsor of 8 bills heading into the 2025 session. Sara Jones, a personal injury attorney, is on the Polk County School Board. Travares McCurdy was the incumbent in FLHD 46 2022-22.

Sarah Rockwell, another RFS graduate, won a seat on the Alachua County Bd. of Ed. and was unanimously chosen as chair

in 2024.
